The 2017 edition consists of the following components:

Asia Smart App Awards 2017

Introduction

To recognize the excellence of innovative smart app development and provide a platform for top smart app professionals in the region to meet, share, collaborate and learn from each other, the Hong Kong Wireless Technology Industry Association (WTIA),organizes the Asia Smart App Awards 2017, riding on the successful Asia Smartphone Apps Contest. By joining forces with the co-organizers from Indonesia, Israel, Japan, Korea, Mainland China, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Taiwan, Thailand and Vietnam, WTIA will bring this timely event to further facilitate the growth of the burgeoning smart app sector in Asia.

The Awards received overwhelming support with entries collected from 11 regions/ countries. They were assessed on the level of Innovation and Creativity, Functionality and Design, User Experience, Technical Deployment of Smartphone Technologies, Market Performance and Competitiveness and Social Responsibility. After two rounds of Assessments conducted by both local and overseas industry professionals, nine finalists were selected to the Final Judging in competing for the category awards.

This Project culminates in a series of events on 29 June 2017, namely the Awards Demo Day, Asia Smart App Summit 2017 and Awards Presentation Ceremony cum Gala Dinner. Industry experts and Award Finalists from the 11 Asian regions will gather in Hong Kong for the events. The events will provide Hong Kong businesses and practitioners in the value chain of smart app an official setting for idea exchange and networking in facilitating the industry growth in a highly positive way.

Business & Productivity

This includes all soltions that target the business and enterprise market of different industries both internally and externally, including applications that facilitate sales, work efficiency, communication, market performance, advertising and market campaign etc.



Game & Entertainment

This includes all kinds of games playable game, whether it is a role playing game, a networked game, multi-player games, or other games. This also includes various digital media served by the smart device platform for information, edutainment or for pure entertainment.



Lifestyle & Social

This includes all digital media served by the smart device plaform for lifestyle and social aspects, including e-publishing, social networking, utilities, lifestyle & travel, education, health & fitness and other related applications.



HKSTP StartUp Award

Sponsored by the Hong Kong Science & Technology Parks Corporation, this award is for the Hong Kong app developers or entrepreneurs who strive for innovative mobile apps development with good business potential. This award is open for individual app developers or startup companies which have been registered in Hong Kong for no more than two years.

In addition, he visited the USA when the VIPs made a state visit, and exchanged ICT related opinions including cyber security with the Information Technology Association of America and American University.

He has gained expertise and built the social network through the exchanges with international organizations including OECD, ITU, ESCAP APT, and UN statistics.


